$$\begin{array}{r} 13 + 16 = \underline{\quad} \\ \begin{array}{r} \swarrow \searrow \\ 10 \quad 3 \end{array} \quad 16 + 10 = 26 \\ 26 + 3 = 29 \end{array}$$

We are learning how to split the smaller number into tens and ones and then add to get the answer.
